Good afternoon

I am writing to raise my grave concerns over the Local Plan, which proposes a minimum of 4200 new homes in the South Warrington area, with a large loss of green belt. Whilst this loss of green belt is not a large percentage in itself, it is almost ALL in the South Warrington area and will change the face of where we live permanently.

I am concerned that little or no importance, given the current political debates on climate change and biodiversity etc, has been given to the ecological impact. What is the point of designating an area as Green Belt if you are not going to stick to it? We must surely be thinking of congestion, air quality and destruction of land and wildlife. Are the local council so out of touch that this does not come high on the agenda?

The poorly thought out infrastructure of roads to serve this new area of housing development, let alone schools, surgeries etc, demonstrates to me a lack of aforethought and I'm afraid smacks of merely re-presenting the plan in a very similar format, rather than fully examining previous objections and proposing viable alternatives.

I am asking you to put a halt to these plans whilst you seriously consider the impact in all its areas
