Hello, I would like to set out below my objections to the modifications to the local plan.

We note that the Six56 is still going to appeal and is left out of the plan so too should the housing associated with employment on Homes England be stopped.

The number of houses to be built on the Green Belt owned by Homes England (modification reduced due to separate appeal for SIX56) should be taken out of the plan as there is no need for housing.

Removal of land from the Green Belt

The amount has been modified from 580ha to 390ha.

This use of Green Belt for housing is not necessary as should be using economic land supply which should equate to jobs and businesses.

The figure for Economic land has been modified down to 168 ha. Land released for Omega was enough supply up to 2035 and now a further 100ha is provided at Fiddlers Ferry. Surely this is evidence that SIX56 must not go ahead on Green Belt.

No need for 5 year supply of land for housing, as this meant having to use Green Belt, the National targets are advisory not mandatory.

Many authorities are pausing the plan process until more clarity.

Another reason is that lack of funding for infrastructure which is needed for SEWUE and this is not in the plan.
