As no modifications have been made to reduce the size of the South East Warrington Urban Extension all our previous concerns re loss of green belt and increase of traffic and demand on services remain. We need to be increasing green areas to help reduce global warming, not concreting more areas, so reducing areas for wildlife and reducing drainage with increased risks of flooding! There are already not enough doctors and dentists for the existing population. Roads get grid locked when there are problems on the motorways.
