THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) CONSOLIDATION
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that the Council made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers on 9th August 2023. The effect of the Order is as follows: -

1. The Borough of Warrington (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation (Amendment No. 2) Order 2019, is hereby further varied or amended as follows: -
 - (a) The Schedule Article (b) in so far as it relates to Marsh Street Car Park and the “Maximum period of stay/period of no return” is amended to the following:
Maximum period of stay is 4 hours, no return within 2 hours, except for Blue Badge Holders.

The Order will be effective from 15th August 2023.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 9th August 2023, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
