Further to your email below, I'd be grateful if you could provide some clarification on the situation in order to assist the Inspector and the public inquiry process which is due to re-commence at the beginning of October.

The applicant's shadow HRA conclusions seem to suggest that if the application is determined before the Local Plan is adopted, they would not make a contribution towards Holcroft Moss restoration measures. They also say that if

the application is determined after the Local Plan is adopted, it would be tested against Policy ENV8, which requires certain types of development to make a proportionate contribution towards restoration measures at the moss, although they say that the SAC Habitat Mitigation Plan referred to in the policy hasn't been developed so there is currently no mechanism to calculate a contribution from the development. As you're aware, we're currently developing the mechanism for contributions towards the moss and, subject to receipt of the Local Plan Inspectors' final report, we anticipate being in a position to adopt the new Local Plan this calendar year. In view of this information, can you clarify whether a contribution towards restoration measures at the moss is required in order mitigate the impacts of the development and make it acceptable.
