WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (PARKSIDE DEVELOPMENT) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that the Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order will be as follows:

- 1. The Orders specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Notice are revoked to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 2. To prohibit any Motor Vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed along **Parkside Road (Unclassified)** from its junction with Golborne Road to its junction with A573 Parkside Link Road/A573 Parkside Road, except for the purpose of access.
- 3. To introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.
- 4. To introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice.
- 5. To introduce a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice.
