TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT – AMENDMENT NO. 63

STATEMENT OF REASONS

TRO951 - Alfa Way, Borsodi Boulevard & Fortress Boulevard (Omega) NWAAT

As part of the ongoing large scale residential developments forming the wider Omega Development it is deemed necessary to introduce a Prohibition of Waiting at any time on the distributor routes. Properties have off street parking and the measures will maintain visibility for the safe passage of residents and ultimately providing public transport links through the estate to promote and encourage sustainable transport.

TRO1004 - Regency Square NWAAT

The development is now complete and prior to adoption it is deemed necessary to introduce the proposed measures to ensure the link road from Bewsey Road and the immediate junction remains free of parked vehicles which reduce forward visibility and affect the efficient flow of vehicles and delivery vehicles into and out of the estate.

TRO1049 - Manchester Road NWAAT

Complaints have been received as a result of vehicles parking on the footway and subsequently reducing the effective width. This has resulted in pedestrians being forced to walk within the carriageway.

TRO1050 - Belmont Avenue Passageway NWAAT

Waste Services regularly encounter difficulties arising from parked vehicles whilst servicing the properties to the rear and within the passageway to the side of No.1 Belmont Avenue. Parked vehicles prevent access for the vehicle and operatives trying to undertake their duties. The restrictions will only be in force on the day of the waste removal covering the anticipated hours of the operation.

Disabled Persons Parking Place Removals:-

To seek approval to remove Disabled Persons Parking Places. Due to a change in circumstances; whether the resident has moved house or unfortunately passed away, numerous requests for the removal of existing disabled persons parking places have been received. They have been assessed and confirmation sought that the bays are no longer required by the applicant.
