A573 Parkside Road	From its Administerial Boundary with St Helens Council to its junction with A573 Parkside Link Road.
A579 Winwick Lane	From its junction with A49 / M6 Junction 22 to its Administerial Boundary with St Helens Council.
A579 Winwick Lane	From its Administerial Boundary with St Helens Council for a distance of approximately 140 metres in a north easterly direction.
Winwick Lane Service Road (Unclassified)	From its Administerial Boundary with St Helens Council for its entire length.
