## A57 Manchester Road Structural Maintenance Starting 11 March 2024 for 6 Weeks

Motorists, Residents and Businesses are advised that major works to resurface the road along A57 MANCHESTER ROAD, between Warburton Bridge Road and Glazebrook Lane, are programmed to commence on 11 March 2024, and will take up to 6 weeks to complete. The works will take place with road closures between 7:00pm and 1:00am. All roads will be fully open to traffic outside the working times.

If possible during Phase 3 the A57 will be reopened to westbound traffic whenever it is safe to do so.

The Signed Diversion Route will be B5212 Glazebrook Lane, B5212 Holcroft Lane, A574 Warrington Road, A574 Birchwood Park Avenue, A574 Birchwood Way, B5210 Woolston Grange Avenue and vice versa.
