2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Warrington, WA1 1UH on any day after the date of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 5th April 2024.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 2nd May 2024.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 16 April 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Warrington, WA1 1UH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 17th April 2024 . You may apply online or download a form at <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote> or contact the Electoral Registration Office direct.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate (free voter ID, or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election, must reach the at Town Hall, Warrington, WA1 1UH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2024.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Warrington, WA1 1UH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2024. 8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, work, or lost voter ID, where that occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2024, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Warrington, WA1 1UH by 5pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2024.
