Corduroy hazard paving to provide tactile warning of shared use footway

Vegetation clearance and tree removals may be required, existing dead tree stumps to be removed

Existing footpath to be widened to accommodate a shared use facility

Lighting improvements to be made throughout alignment so that path can be used year round

Proposed staggered access barriers to slow cyclists approaching crossing point while allowing for accessibility requirements

Longer term connection to Greenall's Avenue to be investigated in future Phase 2 of the scheme

Provision to be made for cyclists to cross at Toucan crossing and rejoin carriageway at a safe access point
