
## **Essential Roadworks**

## Cromwell Avenue Roundabouts Structural Maintenance 13 October 2025 for up to 6 Weeks



Residents, Businesses and Motorists are advised that works to resurface two roundabouts along CROMWELL AVENUE, Chapelford & Old Hall, are programmed to commence from 13 October 2025 and will take up to 6 weeks to complete.

The roads will be closed between 7:00pm and 1:00am to undertake the works safely.

All roads will be fully open to traffic outside these times.

The works will start with the roundabout at Westbrook Crescent/Callands Road and then take place at the roundabout at Westbrook Way.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the works. Vehicular access will be under the control of the Contractor on site.

The signed diversion route will be via Europa Boulevard, Westbrook Crescent and vice versa.
