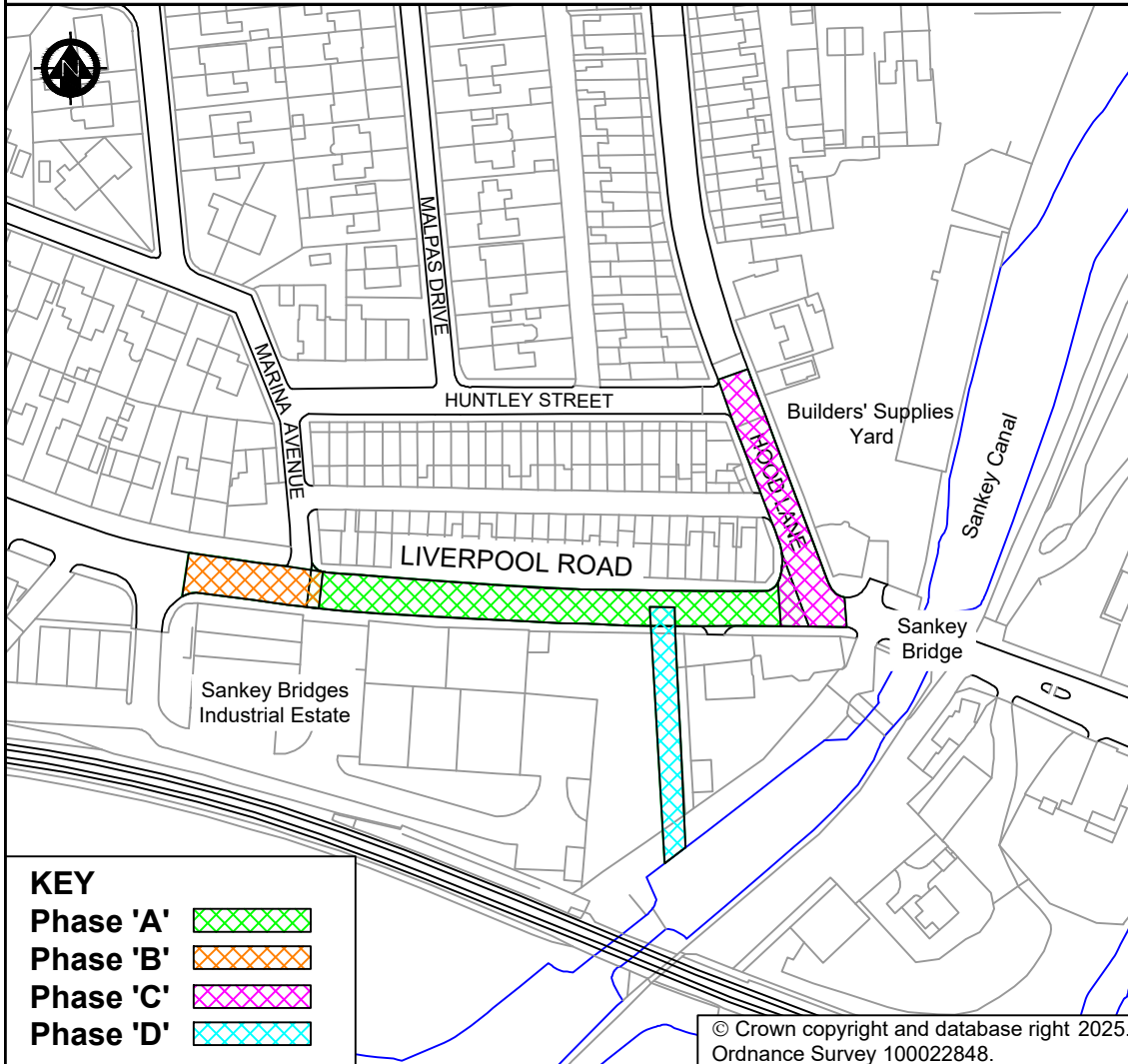


Drainage Works

Liverpool Road Flood Risk Management Scheme From 13 October 2025 - Sankey Bridges Area Business Access



The works are being phased to minimise disruption as much as possible whilst these major works take place from 13 October 2025 to Spring 2026.

Due to the nature of the works to excavate and lay new drainage pipes road closures may be in place 24/7 until each phase has been completed.

The contractors will speak to any businesses whose access will be directly affected by the works, e.g. businesses on Liverpool Road between Hood Lane and Marina Avenue for Phase 'A'.

General businesses access

Phase 'A' - Liverpool Road Closure

For businesses east of the closure access should be from Thewlis St/Old Liverpool Rd
For businesses west of the closure access should be from A562 Penketh Road
Hood Lane and Marina Avenue will be open for other access to businesses.

Phase 'B' - Liverpool Road/Marina Avenue Closure

For businesses east of the closure access should be from Thewlis St/Old Liverpool Rd
For businesses west of the closure access should be from A562 Penketh Road
Hood Lane will be open for other access to businesses.

Phase 'C' - Liverpool Road/Hood Lane Closure

For businesses east of the closure access should be from Thewlis St/Old Liverpool Rd
For businesses west of the closure access should be from A562 Penketh Road
Marina Avenue will be open for other access to businesses

Phase 'D' - Narrow Lanes/Traffic Signals on Liverpool Road

Business Access as normal.
